


THE COMPLETE PERSEPOLIS

- Marjane Satrapi grew up in Tehran during the Iranian Revolution. In her graphic memoir, she recounts the painful and difficult time after the Shah fell. She describes the crackdown on civil liberties when she was a schoolgirl and being sent away at 14 to a boarding school in Vienna to protect her from the increasingly harsh regime in power.
- Satrapi's acclaimed graphic memoir covers her coming of age, return to Iran, and eventual self-imposed exile from home. She now lives and works in France.




WHERE MEN WIN GLORY:
